The Story of Cooperation with Daxx

We had a pretty bad Android app and a very basic iOS app that didn't have all the features we offered on our website, so we needed to hire a mobile app developer who could help us reach those of our users who prefer to browse product prices on their phones. Our previous experience with IT outsourcing wasn't very successful, so we started looking for a better option and decided to partner up with Daxx.
