Southwark London Borough Council has made an historic commitment to providing 11,000 new council homes by 2043. As part of this ambition, they partnered with the Greater London Authority to prepare a new area action plan (AAP) for the Old Kent Road. They established a community forum, ran a host of community consultation events and opened a series of formal surveys online – all managed through Citizen Space. As the plan moves through its development stages, ahead of its submission to the Secretary of State, the council have made sure that 'all residents, business owners and other interested people have the opportunity to comment on the plan'.
