Managing hundreds of licenses

With Adobe Creative Cloud for teams, Mok can manage all Creative Cloud for teams licenses from the central Admin Console. Rather than installing software on individual machines, Mok simply assigns an employee an account that they can use to download software as needed.

The Admin Console provides an overview of what software users have downloaded, enabling Mok to track licenses easily. Custom software packages offer even tighter control over software access, enabling Rockwell Group to distribute licenses thoughtfully using Creative Cloud Packager. At the same time, Mok can easily give power users the ability to download and experiment with any app within Creative Cloud without needing to personally install every piece of software on their computers.

"Adobe Creative Cloud for teams makes it very easy for me to assign and manage licenses across the company from a central location using the Admin Console," says Mok. "I spend half as much time now managing licenses with Adobe Creative Cloud than I did previously with boxed software."

The regular cost structure of Adobe Creative Cloud also makes it easy for Rockwell Group to budget for software. Before, Rockwell Group would need to make a large investment every few years to purchase new software or upgrade existing software. The upgrade cycle was not always regular, making it difficult to accurately predict long-term budgets. Working together through Adobe

Rockwell Group uses Adobe software frequently in the design and proposal process, creating polished proposals through a combination of apps in Creative Cloud for teams. "Adobe programs teach designers how to structure and present their ideas in a meaningful way on a daily basis, fostering the creation of beautiful and realistic renderings for our clients to conceptualize," says Samantha Ricken, Designer, Rockwell Group.

Adobe Photoshop CC works well to create presentation-ready images that accurately reflect the designer's vision for the space while Adobe Illustrator CC is often used to create a new logo or fresh branding concept for a new project.

Designers import the images and graphics into Adobe InDesign CC to storyboard the direction of a project, from the initial concept to the schematic design phase, where designers carefully select furniture and finalize the materials palette. Using Adobe Acrobat DC, Designers export InDesign proposals into high-quality PDF slide decks for easier collaboration and reviews with internal or external collaborators.

"The search function helps us find the specific tools we need quickly and easily, and the stamp tool shows the name, date, and time of a reviewer to clarify approvals on a sketch."

Libraries make it easy for designers to find and reuse up-to-date assets for any app on any computer.
