Navigating a Fragmented Regulatory Landscape

Avolta operates across a range of European markets, each with its own compliance regulations, government portals, and technical formats for electronic invoicing. Staying aligned with constantly evolving mandates posed a significant challenge, particularly as new timelines and standards continued to emerge.

Managing this landscape with multiple local vendors or internal solutions would have introduced complexity and risk. The Accounts Payable (AP) team would have had to navigate varied technical requirements, monitor changes in real time, and ensure consistent internal control standards—all while maintaining business continuity and supporting ongoing automation goals.

With upcoming mandates such as France's e-invoicing reform and similar legislation in Italy and

Poland, Avolta recognized the need for a unified strategy that could keep them compliant today and adaptable for the future.

A Centralized Compliance Platform


