Challenges

Before, board meeting materials were based on information derived from email attachments, which led to a time - consuming and manual process of assembling materials via decks and other documents. As the company grew, the governance challenges began to grow with it — leading to a growing need for a smarter, more efficient governance process powered by Al:


- Expanding board packs: Board packs grew from 20 to 30 pages to over 100 pages, making the process of managing and distributing documents cumbersome and inefficient. The volume of information in the packs often overwhelmed board members, making it difficult for them to prepare and stay informed about key points.
- Manual methods: The company relied on manual processes like sending emails with numerous attachments. With little flow to the attachments sent, the board's ability to review the documents in the appropriate context was limited. This added to the administrative burden, and the heightened security risk greatly increased the chance of important details being overlooked.
- No single source of truth: With so much content coming in through different senders and sources, the governance administration team needed a more efficient way to gather and present information, so all board members had access to the same range of data.

Solutions

To address these challenges, Arran's team turned to Diligent Boards and its purpose - built suite of artificial intelligence capabilities, GovernAl. Arran was initially skeptical about using Al, as he was unclear on how much value it could bring to his team. Over time, his view shifted as he spoke with Diligent and saw that it could add more than he originally expected. Once implemented, the benefits started to stack up:

 Al-generated summaries: Instead of reading through 100+ page board packs, directors now receive meaningful summaries with Al Smart Book Summary. This helps them prepare them for board meetings with an overview of areas in the business that might not be under their jurisdiction.

- Integration with other tools: Diligent Boards integrates seamlessly with systems like Docusign and Google Drive, ensuring actions that happen in one system happen in the other.


