C5 OVERVIEW
is the German Federal Office for Information Security (Bundesamt für Sicherheit in der Informationstechnik, or BSI) created the Cloud Computing Compliance Controls Catalog (C5). C5 is a set of compliance controls needed for cloud service providers (CSPs) seeking to establish a mandatory minimum baseline for cloud security and the adoption of public cloud solutions by the German government and organizations that work with the government. The standard is increasingly being adopted by the German private sector.

C5 also combines existing security standards from international organizations, such as Information Security Management (ISO), International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) 27001 and Cloud Controls Matrix of the Cloud Security Alliance (CSA CCM).
