Context & Goals

ACCIONA's supply chain is highly dynamic, encompassing more than 67,000 tier 1 business partners across 40 countries. The company uses the IntegrityNext platform to achieve the following objectives:

- Automate and optimize supplier prequalification
- Conduct a comprehensive risk analysis of critical suppliers
- Enhance supplier engagement
- Strengthen the sustainable procurement strategy

Project Description

Close collaboration between sustainability and compliance, procurement, and IT ensured the seamless integration of IntegrityNext assessments and data into ACCIONA's electronic tendering and procurement management system.

The company continuously monitors more than 67,000 suppliers, with new ones being added each month due to a high change rate. Depending on their risk profile, suppliers must provide detailed information on specific ESG topics.

Key Outcomes

- **More efficient supplier prequalification:** Onboarding time per supplier reduced by approximately 63% through streamlined processes
- **Sustainable supplier selection:** 98% of high-risk suppliers successfully pre-qualified
- **Scalability:** 12,000 new suppliers onboarded annually; more than 1,000 employees across various ACCIONA departments use IntegrityNext data
- **Enhanced DJSI rating:** Improved performance in the Dow Jones Sustainability Index (DJSI)
