The international law firm needed to upgrade to ensure communications with its clients were not slowed down due to compatibility issues between different versions of Office. In addition, the firm needed to maintain the highest levels of stability, performance and security for more than 2,400 desktops and laptops. Building and managing a single Windows 7 and Office 2010 image able to seamlessly integrate with more than 500 applications and add-ins was the primary challenge. This was further complicated by the desire to centrally deploy this image to 17 offices around the world without impacting the productivity of more than 880 attorneys.

Single Windows 7 Image

Custom Development

iVision is also extending the firm's internally developed iMX application. The application maintains a secure desktop configuration while enabling attorneys and staff to install applications and hardware with a dynamic security key provided by the help desk.
