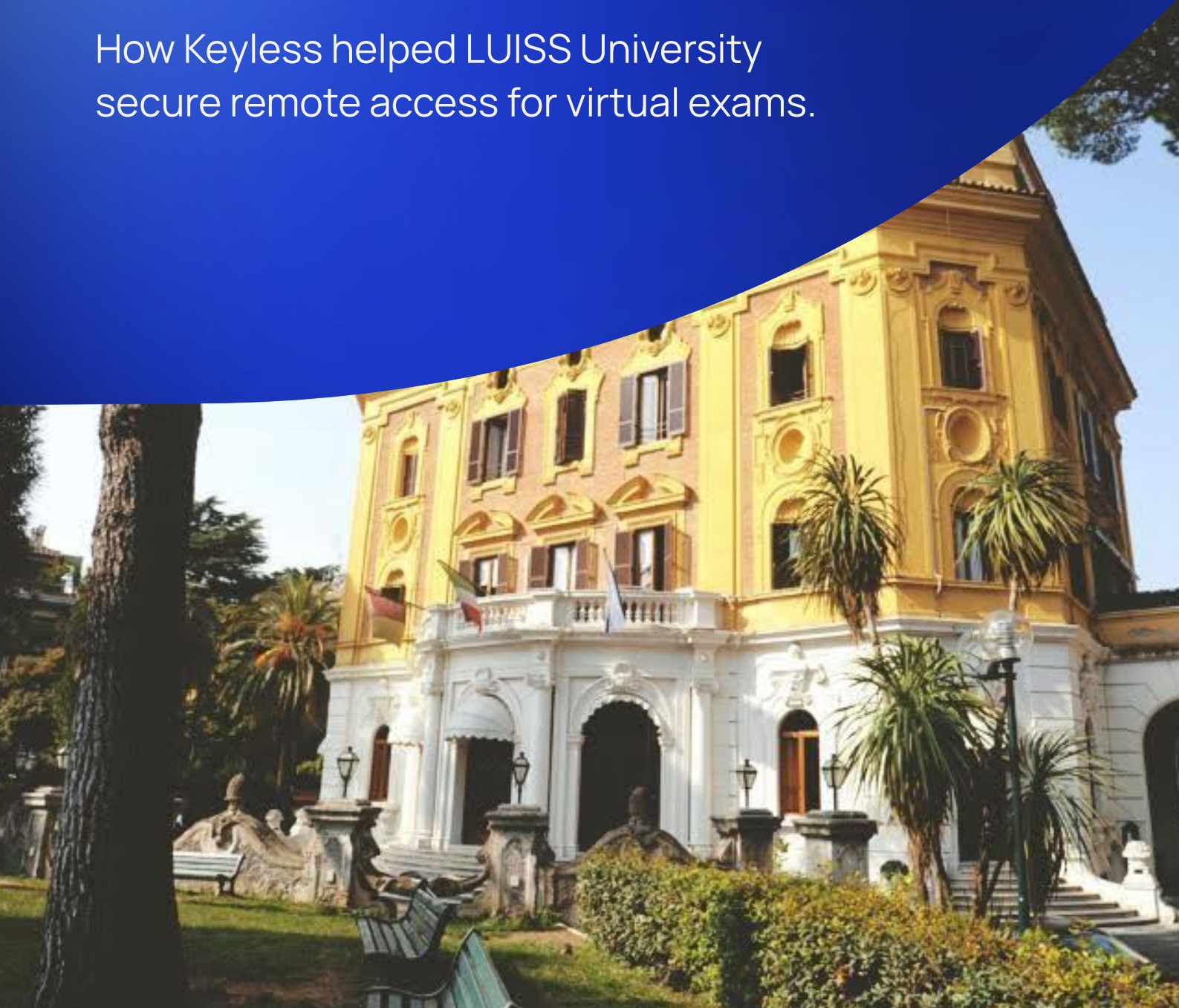

Record and Monitor Attendance

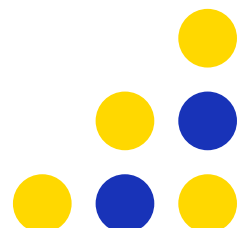
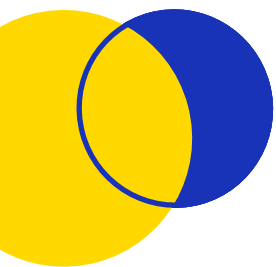
Ensure the correct student is present. Record the attendance of individual students and acknowledge their presence in the exam or class, while preserving their privacy.

Student and faculty authentication to business Applications, VPN and SSO in a data-sensitive sector.

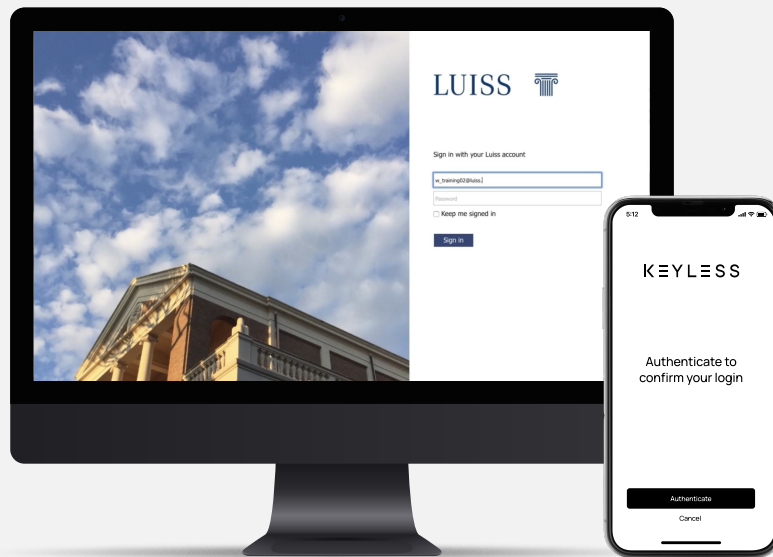
Built-in privacy-preserving multi-factor authentication for any application to reduce security risks while preserving student and staff privacy and enhancing the authentication flow user experience.

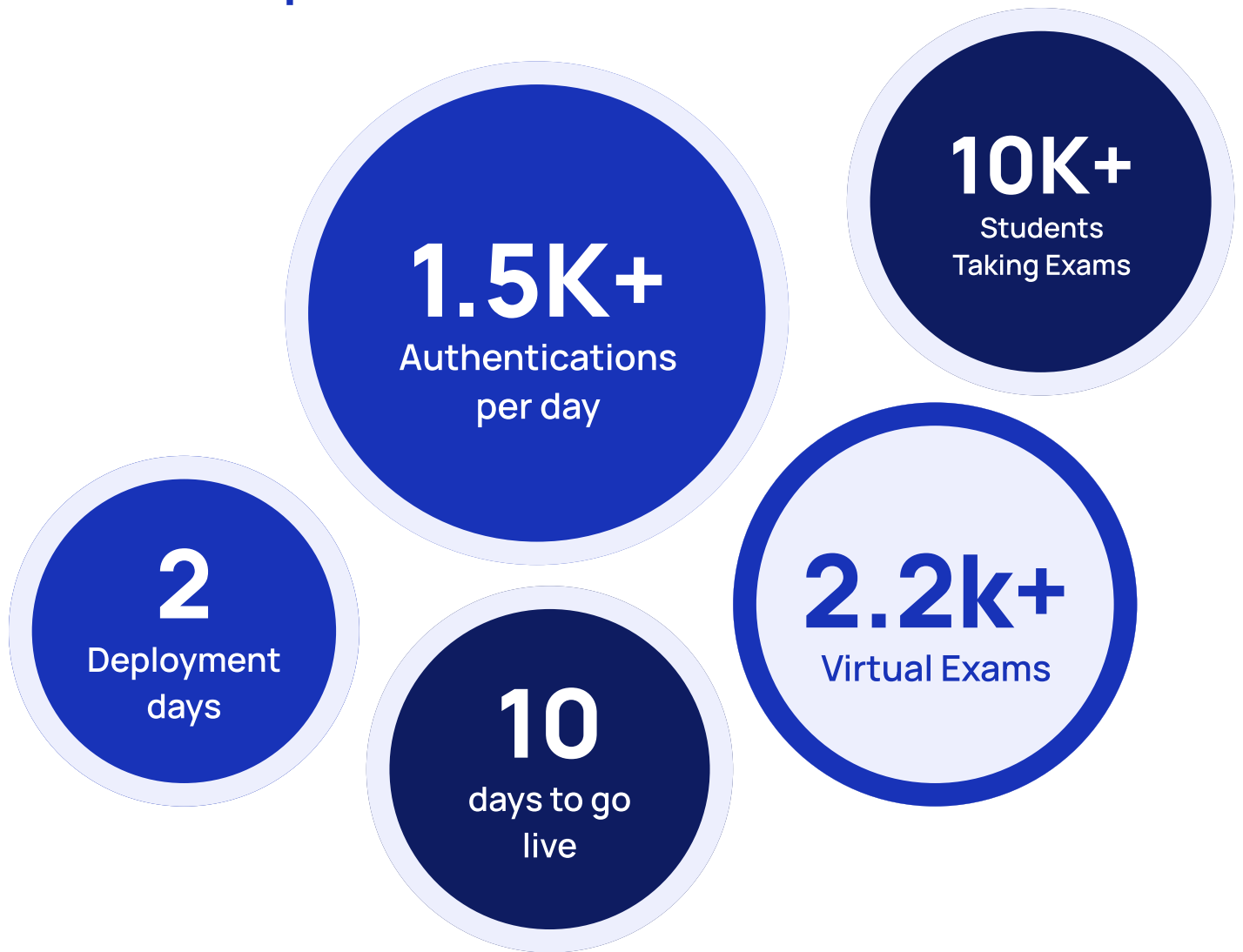
