

Enabling Rural Hospitalswith Smarter Contracting

The Rural Collaborative, a membership-based organization supporting 28 rural hospitals, needed to improve its contract review process. Each contract had the potential to impact dozens of stakeholders, making accuracy and efficiency nonnegotiable. With a small contracting team and a high volume of diverse contracts, they found an effective solution in LegalOn's Al-powered platform.

Challenge

Tianna Fallgatter wears a lot of hats for The Rural Collaborative— she is a contract specialist and the Director of Business Development. Tianna is responsible for managing all third-party contracts—including NDAs, MSAs, SaaS agreements, and shared purchasing deals. Every contract negotiation starts from the vendor paper, requiring hours of manual review and redlining.

"We don't have templates, so every contract is new. It's a time suck, and the risk of missing something critical is high," Tianna shared.

The growing volume of agreements each potentially impacting all 28 member hospitals—demanded a more efficient and risk-aware approach. Tianna and her assistant Kaley faced significant challenges managing contracts for the organization:

- Manual review process: Each contract required extensive line-by-line review
- Diverse agreement types: Tianna and Kaley manage MSAs, NDAs, BAAs, SaaS agreements, and other specialized contracts
- High risk of errors: Missing critical clauses previously resulted in substantial financial losses
- Time constraints: Contract review consumed entire workdays, competing with Tianna's many other responsibilities

Before LegalOn, reviewing and redlining a single contract could take Tianna a full business day, limiting her capacity to handle the organization's growing contract needs.

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Solution

 based on real scenarios. She often asks Assistant what
 terms might increase liability or what's missing for a
 customer like her.
- Searchable repository: With LegalOn's organized folder structure and version chains, the team can track every contract's history and maintain clarity across dozens of active agreements.

"I love using LegalOn Assistant for non-standard agreements," Tianna said. "I just describe the scenario, and LegalOn shows me what's missing and how to fix it."

LegalOn has also helped prevent future contract errors by flagging changes that could otherwise go unnoticed. Tianna recalled an experience where a vendor altered contract terms before signature, resulting in a six-figure revenue shortfall. "Now, with LegalOn Compare, I can catch changes instantly," she said. "It's a safety net that protects us from ever repeating that kind of oversight."

Implementation

Implementation was quick and seamless. LegalOn's intuitive design allowed the team to get started immediately, while onboarding support from their Customer Success Manager made the transition easy.

Tianna created organized folders for each contract, and both she and Kaley quickly adapted to features like Al Review, version tracking, and general terms guidance. "The onboarding team was fantastic—super friendly and knowledgeable," Tianna said.

LegalOn has become very valuable in quickly identifying what's missing and helping me insert what should be added. It has helped me identify risk much better, in areas I may have completely missed before.




The Game-Changer: LegalOn Compare
