What is VMware?

VMware is a virtualization technology and platform designed for companies who want to build virtualization solutions for end-user needs, including delivering individual virtualized applications, providing secure mobile and remote desktop access, and providing users with the ability to run their applications and desktops from anywhere in the world when combined with Microsoft Remote Desktop Services (RDS).

Why is VMware utilizing Remote Desktop Services (RDS)?

VMware, backed by RDS connections for ease of use, was an excellent fit for Jack's Tire & Oil Management Company for several reasons, including cost, scalability, and support.
