Challenge

Specialising in architecture and design, ASTA-technologies presents every client with printed documentation relating to each project. All documentation must include detailed project information and provide clear images that enable customers to visualise the design of a completed project. ASTA-technologies print plans and designs that are then presented to customers, so it is essential the documents are consistently printed in a professional quality, particularly when it comes to the colourful design elements. The company had been using a wide format inkjet printer and mono MFP from two well-known brands that failed to deliver a satisfactory quality for their customers.

"The plotter on the existing equipment does not print A3 and A4 formats. This means, we have to manually cut these documents out of wider sheets in order to fit them into our document folders", says Dmitry Astashev, co-owner of ASTA-technologies.

The existing MFP was not equipped with a network card, as a result, users had to store all the scanned materials on one PC connected to the MFP via USB. Scanned images were rarely deleted from the system, resulting in up to 2,000 images a year taking up valuable storage space on the one PC. This created significant problems for the system administrator and disruption to the document workflow.
