## 'No More Wasted Trees and Ink' – How Oklahoma Housing Finance Agency Saved Time and Money with Beanworks



<u>Oklahoma Housing Finance Agency</u> helps people get access to affordable homes by providing support such as rent assistance and loans.

Since 1975, the non-profit has grown from just 12 field agents to an organization that helps more than 25,000 families per year.

"Invoices and other documents required numerous pages, which all had to be printed and filed," said Controller, Ron Wolf. "They often ended up getting duplicated, which meant more wasted trees and ink."

As their cabinets filled up with paper, it was time to address these old processes and look for a better way of doing things.

Before Beanworks, an AP accountant and bookkeeper would <u>manually\_code</u> each invoice. But this could cause problems down the line in Sage 100 if there was an error and it was not spotted in time. The process needed to become more efficient and accurate.
