With 400 employees in 40 locations across its four divisions in North America, Rand Worldwide had been planning to upgrade its internal communications platform to Microsoft Teams, and had arranged to host in-person training sessions at locations across the country.



Dominic Yu, Director of IT and Project Management, Rand Worldwide, said, "We expected that the move to Microsoft Teams would require a lot of change management, as it was going to change the way all employees communicated with each other. We originally thought that in-person, hands-on training would be the best way to ensure complete buy-in from everyone. Then the health concerns of the COVID-19 virus came about, and we had to come up with another plan."
