Go IT Services, a Sitefinity service partner, develops a professional new website that captured the vision and strategic objectives of Arnold Oil Company.

THE CHALLENGE

Arnold Oil was in the process of re-imaging their stores with bold red, white and blue colors. Their aging website also needed to be redesigned to promote their business more effectively, include the company's history, and illustrate who they are and what they do.

Arnold Oil also wanted to have better control over the website and maintain it more easily. Specifically, they wanted business users to be able to update content, have a workflow for managing the migration of changes to the published site, and the ability to create new pages without technical skills.

In addition, Arnold Oil had invested in SharePoint as their internal collaborative tool, and wished to centralize the key data about their business within it. The public website should be able to retrieve data directly from SharePoint, such as their offered services, locations, and product lines.

THE SOLUTION

A component was developed to retrieve XML data and images from SharePoint lists via Web Services. The retrieval process was activated from a simple button placed within a tools page of the website that was restricted to authorized users belonging to a special role.

Several user controls were developed to read the XML data that had been saved locally on the web server to provide the customized functionality that was required. This included:

- A rotating ad banner on the home page.
- A graphical display of services.
- A list of manufacturer product lines organized by category.
- Locations organized by areas and displayed on Google Maps with drilldown to view specific store details.

The remainder of the site comprised of textual content and static images, plus forms to join the mailing list and locate parts.
