# THE CHALLENGE

Our main objective was to manage our store and our website content in one system. We wanted to share login data between our store and website, set-up content management workflows, add meta tags through the UI, and allow versioning.

We wanted a better framework for adding custom controls. If a property needed to be changed, such as the number of testimonials to be shown, we would like our business users to quickly change a textbox's value instead of code work. Another objective was to drag and drop controls onto pages and have business users adjust layout, without a programmer's help.
