Overview

Lufthansa City Center (LCC) has been experiencing constant growth since its founding in 1991, and today is one of the largest travel agency chains in Germany. The Frankfurt-based company offers and manages virtual desktops for travel agencies that require a flexible, scalable and secure infrastructure and interconnection.

Business challenge

LCC ensures constant availability of the IT systems for a large number of travel agencies. Since all travelers rely on an efficient booking process, the IT systems must guarantee 24-hour access with minimal latency. Travel and tourism is a very competitive market where security and data privacy are critical. Besides the IT solution being cost-effective, flexible and scalable, it was vital that data sovereignty remained within Germany—a benefit that is guaranteed by Platform Equinix*.

One of the main challenges in the project was to combine the best aspects of both the physical and virtual worlds to create a hybrid solution through interconnection. This infrastructure consists of dedicated servers running the operating systems and a flexible public cloud that can scale on demand.

Solution

The complete solution required Equinix and two of its local partners to work simultaneously: Equinix provided colocation and interconnection services for the LCC platform; ProfitBricks provided the infrastructure; and Axians provided consultation and implementation. The process included expanding the hardware for LCC desktops and interconnecting ProfitBricks via Equinix Fabric™.

Once the connected data centers, virtual machines and hosts in the data centers were handed over to the customer, they added their own applications on this infrastructure. In the near future, Microsoft Office applications also will be provided via the ProfitBricks infrastructure.

LCC uses a hybrid solution in the Equinix environment. This solution is comprised of public cloud and dedicated servers with ProfitBricks providing Infrastructure as a Service (laaS) and dedicated hosting from Axians. The main challenges included the licensing conditions and guaranteed performance for each virtual machine.

The entire desktop environment runs on Platform Equinix in Frankfurt, Germany, in a dedicated hardware environment provided by Axians. The operating systems are relatively static so the required space for the infrastructure can be planned. Since the business applications are updated and refined constantly and therefore require a flexible cloud environment, they are run within the ProfitBricks cloud.

While the company applications are in the ProfitBricks cloud, these applications are updated and refined constantly to suit a flexible cloud environment.

As its central components, Platform Equinix and Equinix Fabric form the basis of the solution. The services provided by Axians and ProfitBricks create an optimal and efficient hybrid cloud concept. Together this lays the foundation for LCC to leverage an Interconnection Oriented Architecture* (IOA*) strategy to bring applications and services closer to users, optimize multicloud connectivity and boost performance.

Business results

A significant advantage was the diversity of Platform Equinix with partners such as Axians and ProfitBricks. Equinix, Axians and ProfitBricks seamlessly planned and integrated the complex projects to provide services such as dedicated servers and public cloud solutions while guaranteeing that all data access and storage takes place within Germany.

Finally, a further benefit is the proximity to the DE-CIX international data exchange point. LCC data centers are distributed across the Equinix International Business Exchange™ (IBX*) data centers (FR2 and FR4) for security reasons, which are connected via Metro Connect*.

Value realized

Ultimately, this solution provides travel agencies with a low-latency client connection and implements a flexible provision of development resources for IT. In addition, the solution accesses a dedicated Internet Breakout Point from where data traffic crosses over to the internet. Performance is improved as the distance covered via the internet is kept short. Latency is kept to a bare minimum due to physical proximity of ProfitBricks to the servers from Axians within the Equinix platform. A user in the travel agency will not notice that the desktop is running on an infrastructure separate to the one hosting the applications.

The travel agencies connected to the LCC platform are legally independent entities and have a franchise relationship with LCC. This means that LCC is not allowed to buy and lease any licenses such as those for Microsoft applications. For this purpose, there are special licensing agreements called SPLA licenses. From a licensing perspective, LCC was not in a position to adapt an SPLA model. To alleviate the licensing issue, Axians, a Microsoft SPLA partner, hosts the Microsoft operating systems, which also provides increased security levels and improved system availability.

This concept can be used as a blueprint for franchise companies or those with many branches. It offers seamless scalability from smaller environments (from 20 virtual desktops) to large corporate environments. The separate expansion of virtual desktop infrastructure with Axians and application infrastructure with ProfitBricks provides the option of integrating proper licensing for Windows desktops with maximum scalability of resources for employees.
