Northgate's new shared technology platform provides police forces with a single source of data, and integrates and supports a suite of critical applications from the street to the court. Using Uniface, we were able to deliver a step-change in capability, both in terms of functionality and delivery. We have replaced multiple silo-based applications with a single data source, integrating information in an innovative, new approach to transform the way police forces operate across the country. Uniface allowed us to do this rapidly and securely.

Cloud

With the Uniface development environment, there is no on-premise requirement. Instead, we offer a multi-tenanted private cloud, using identity and access management control, and we audit to ensure the highest level of security. Using a web browser, users have seamless access to shared applications, removing the need to re-key data and streamlining processes.

Scalability

Our platform allows police forces to achieve cost and efficiency savings through collaboration. An individual force will typically have several thousands of users, and as more forces join the platform volumes will increase significantly, up to an expected level of some 100,000 users. Uniface allows us to support increasing end-user numbers with no disruption to services.

Who We Are and What We Do

Northgate Public Services is a market leader in providing specialist software, outsourcing and ICT services to the human resources, local government and public safety markets.

The original company was founded in 1969 and since that time has built up over 40 years' experience in the ICT industry. The group currently employs over 12,000 staff in more than 46 countries and across five continents. Clients include around 1,000 multi-national companies, and more than 20 per cent of Global Fortune 500 organizations, as well as a wide range of public service providers.

Our Uniface Application

Northgate Public Services has been providing police and criminal justice agencies with world-class IT solutions for over 20 years. Our vision is to transform the way in which we deliver the core capabilities for policing, by providing a single source of data which will allow police forces to collaborate and share data in four key areas: Intelligence, crime investigation, managing defendants in custody and case file preparation for court.

Using Uniface, we have undertaken a major development program to build a platform which allows different police forces to connect information, align processes and share costs. This is the largest-ever collaborative police IT project outside of a national program. The development team consists of 45 developers working both in the UK and India who collaborate together on the project.

As well as sharing information more easily across police boundaries, our platform will allow police forces to significantly streamline the way they record data within the force. At the moment information on suspects, defendants, witnesses and missing people is often stored in different databases, all of which have to be updated separately. The financial savings that will come from using one shared IT system will allow forces to maintain investment in frontline policing.

Technical Benefits We Gain from Uniface

With about 20 years of Uniface experience, we can state the benefits with confidence.

- In developing our new platform we were looking to move to an entirely different enterprise architecture, which would be hosted on an off-premise cloud and which would offer end users access to information which could be delivered anywhere via a web browser, on a tablet, a desktop PC or any other device.
- Uniface's ability to offer a secure cloud-based solution, with built-in resilience and disaster recovery was critical to this Software as a Service approach, as was its increasing support for mobile devices.
- We already had policing applications which had been written with Uniface, so we had the capability to plug these into the new platform and Uniface made the migration more straightforward and easier.
- We can easily reuse logic from applications written in earlier versions of Uniface (or in Javascript) within a modern Uniface application. This ensured the development team's productivity remained high. We can now offer end users a single application covering a range of activities from crime and intelligence management on the street, through to case preparation for court and custody management.
- Uniface's model-driven environment allowed for the rapid development of applications, with built-in services to simplify deployment and management. This approach increased productivity at the start of the project. We had development teams across five locations, three in the UK and two in India, with development tasks handled seamlessly between them.

Global networking and collaboration is the cornerstone of PartnersUnited. This is done online and through international and regional summits and events. Partner events provide a forum for the senior managers and technical managers of Uniface's partners to come together and discuss compelling topics and look at Uniface development from a business, as well as a technical perspective with the aim of adding value to partners' businesses. - As well as moving legacy applications onto the platform, we wanted to ensure we had a very open architecture going forward. Using Uniface we are able to give end users the ability to engineer their own applications, using the common services we are providing. Uniface allowed us to embrace innovation with APIs that allow third parties to become part of our eco-system.
- Uniface provides a number of different ways of interfacing with third-party systems from web services (high tech) to flat files (low tech).
- A big part of our design methodology is making sure that the platform can stay contemporary. We did not want to limit our customers to always asking us to develop applications in response to local requirements. Instead, we wanted to offer an agile design capability. Uniface allows us to use the identify and asset management and audit features embedded in the platform, both to re-use the data across existing applications and to create data for a larger eco-system.
- Uniface's model-based architecture supports agile design and also enables us to provide the latest user interface without having to change or rewrite the underlying business rules.
- Uniface was instrumental in enabling us to embrace the latest thinking on digital developments in the government sector, which stresses the need to remove any 'lock in' to a single supplier. With this approach, individual police forces will be able to ask local SMEs to develop specialist applications for their use.
- Uniface is platform- and database-independent, so individual police forces are not locked into one supplier for any hardware or software element of our solution. This also makes it easier for different forces to collaborate via our framework, regardless of their hardware platform.

A Future with Uniface

We see our partnership with Uniface continuing to grow and strengthen in the future as we develop our shared platform further and as more police forces come on board and collaborate in sharing data and services. We know we can depend on Uniface to continue to provide high-quality, highly responsive support no matter how large our end-user volumes become. Uniface will be with us all the way as we work to transform the way in which police forces work across the UK and, in the longer term, internationally as well.
