Challenge

Hong Kong's construction industry faces modernization challenges despite "Construction 2.0" initiatives. Rising costs and digitalization demands, especially from government-mandated Common Data Environments (CDEs), highlight the critical role of data for analysis, efficiency, and evidence-based decision-making, often facilitated by AI and joint ventures.

Business Challenges

Build King, one of Hong Kong's leading construction companies, has been in business for more than 45 years. It operates as a principal contractor in the construction industry, undertaking large-scale infrastructure projects in Hong Kong, focusing on three areas: civil engineering, building and environmental.

Many construction processes remain traditional, making modernization and digitalization — through robotics, data, and computerization — a major challenge. The Hong Kong Government is actively promoting “Construction 2.0” and industry-wide digital transformation. Initiatives include Building Information Modeling (BIM), Common Data Environment (CDE), and the Smart Site Safety System (4S).

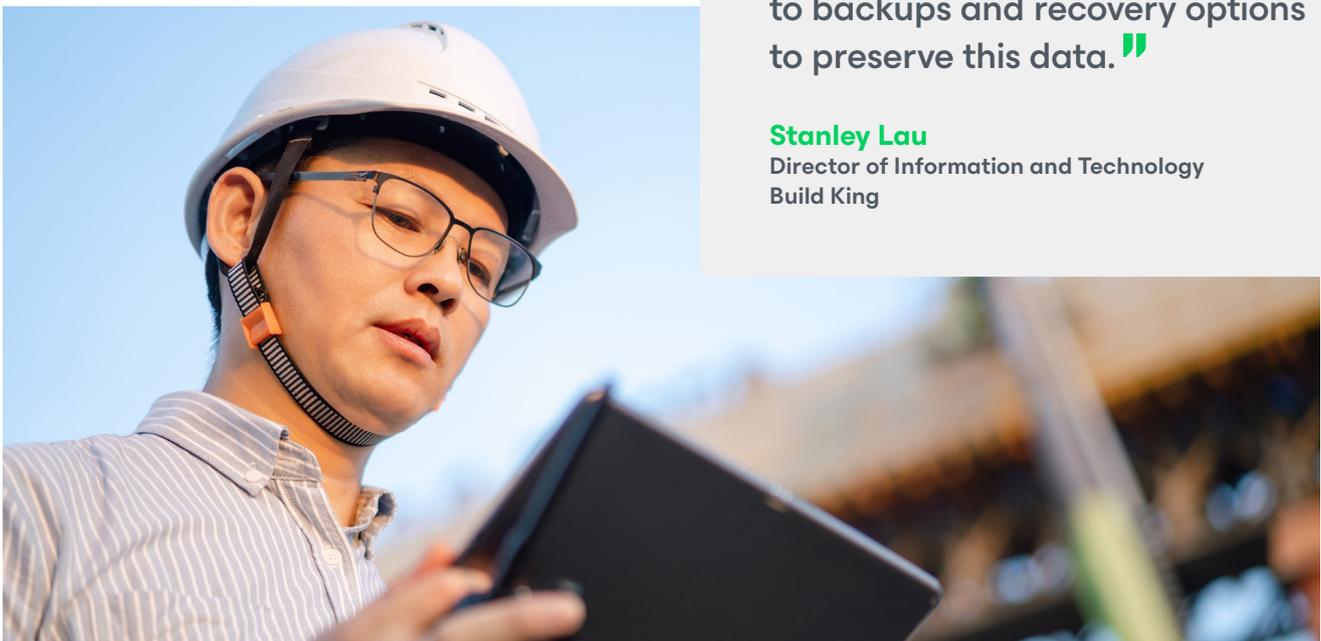
“With government initiatives like the CDE, all data must be digitized and shared with clients and subcontractors. Data is now at the heart of project management, decision-making, and real-time adjustments. Without accurate data, it's impossible to make informed decisions quickly, which is critical in construction projects,” said Stanley Lau, Head of Information Technology at Build King.

While the financial losses from downtime in construction are not yet as severe as in the financial services sector, increasing reliance on real-time data and system access makes IT resilience and redundancy critical. Any data loss or downtime could directly or indirectly delay essential workflows, particularly online operations requiring real-time data.

“Construction projects can span anywhere from four to ten years, with post-completion phases extending into financial settlements and dispute resolutions. Over the course of these projects, long-term employees often accumulate a decade's worth of emails, resulting in mailboxes full of valuable information. This makes it essential to have easy access to backups and recovery options to preserve this data.”

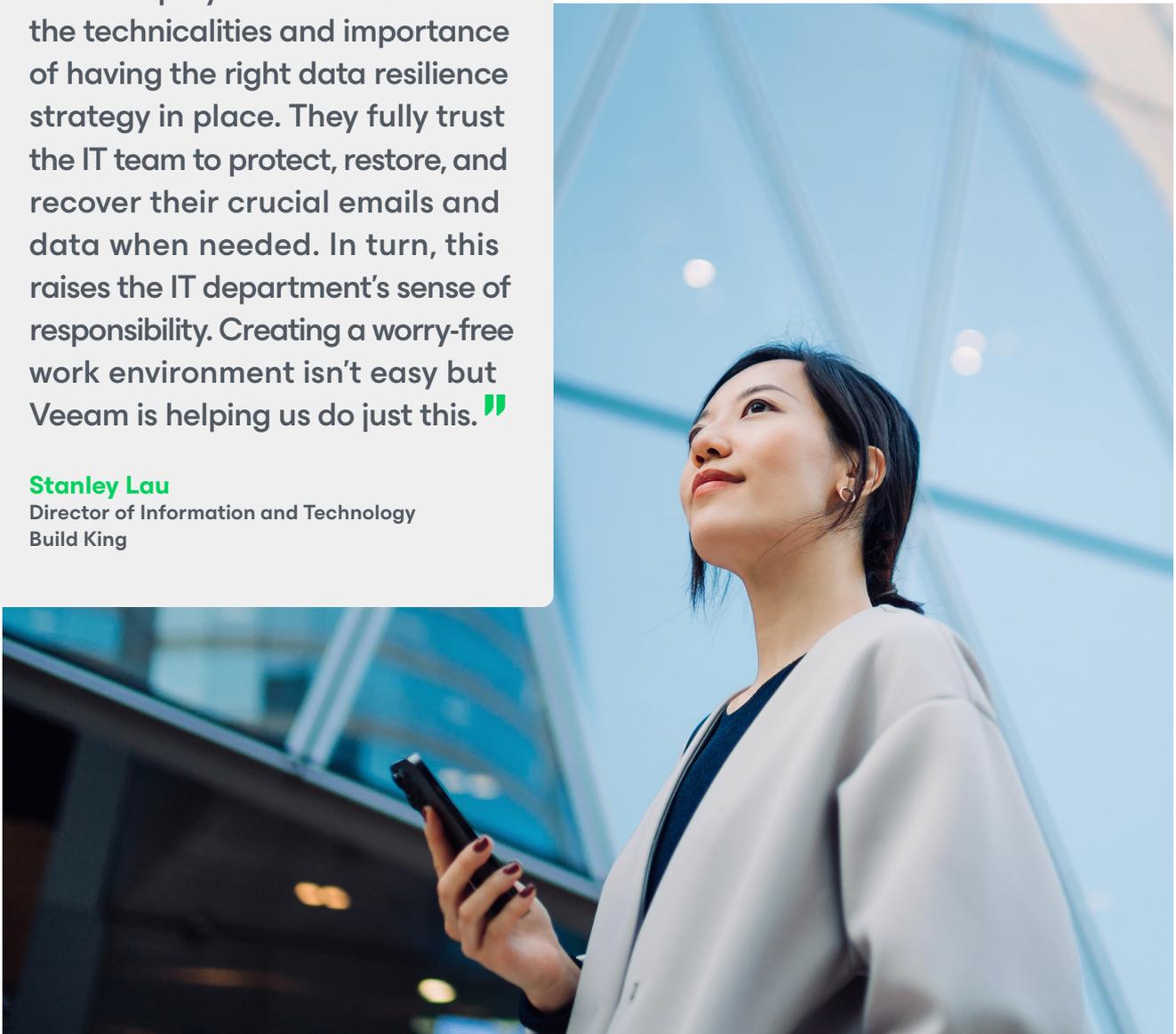

Organizations are working to implement multi-layer protection across data, endpoints, and network perimeters. Build King relies heavily on trusted third-party providers, like Veeam, for protection and cyber resilience.
